Judging Process

Online Participants: Document-Based Evaluation: Judges will initially evaluate online participants based on the submitted documents.

Online Meetings: If additional information is required, participants may be invited to virtual meetings for further clarification.

Offline Participants:

Document-Based Evaluation: Judges will evaluate offline participants based on the documents submitted.

Face-to-Face Interviews (April 28, 2024): Participants will have the opportunity for in-person interviews with judges, allowing for deeper exploration and discussion of their projects.

The judging process is designed to ensure a comprehensive and fair assessment of all participants, regardless of their mode of participation. It encourages open communication and provides an opportunity for participants to showcase the depth and potential of their innovative ideas.

Judging Criteria

Innovation: Is the idea new and innovative? Does it solve a problem or meet a need in an innovative way?

Feasibility: Is the business model feasible? Is there a clear path to market?

Market Potential: Is there a significant market for the product/service? Has the startup demonstrated an understanding of this market?

Presentation Skills: Was the presentation clear, engaging, and professional? Did the startup effectively communicate their idea and business model?

Financial Viability: Does the startup have a clear understanding of their financial requirements? Have they outlined a sound financial plan?

Documents Required for Registration

Completed Registration Form: A form with details about the startup including name, founding date, team members, contact information, etc.

Executive Summary: A 1-2 page summary of the startup's business plan, outlining the problem they're addressing, their solution, and their unique selling proposition.

Business Plan: A detailed business plan outlining the startup's strategy for success, including market analysis, marketing strategy, financial projections, and operational plans.

Declaration of Alignment with Halal Principles: A declaration stating that the startup's product/service aligns with Halal principles. [Optional]


